Subject: **PERIODICAL REVISION OF ELECTORAL ROLLS 2021-2022:**  
**PUBLICATION OF PRELIMINARY ELECTORAL ROLLS**

The Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) is an independent constitutional body mandated to organize and conduct elections and to make necessary arrangements to ensure that election is conducted honestly, justly, fairly and in accordance with the law and that the corrupt practices are guarded against. Preparation of accurate and credible electoral rolls is the first and important step in conducting free, fair and transparent elections.

2. In order to update the current electoral rolls by including therein names of all eligible persons as voters, removing therefrom names of deceased voters and such voters who had become disqualified for being registered as voters and allowing the voters to apply for correction of their voting particulars, the Election Commission decided to carry out Periodical Revision of Electoral Rolls under section 36 of the Elections Act 2017 so that an accurate and updated electoral rolls is made available well before the General Elections-2023.

3. The periodical revision envisaged various phases, i.e. door-to-door verification of Draft Electoral Rolls (DER), door-to-door verification of supplementary list of unverified voters, filing of claims, objections and applications for corrections, disposal thereof by the Revising Authorities and final publication of revised electoral rolls. For undertaking aforesaid activities the ECP appointed enumeration staff across the country as per following details:

4. The first phase of door-to-door verification of Draft Electoral Rolls was held across the country w.e.f 7<sup>th</sup> Nov-31<sup>st</sup> December, 2021. The second phase of door-to-door verification of unverified voters was held w.e.f 4-18<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. Based on verified DER and supplementary list of unverified voters, the Preliminary Electoral Rolls was prepared and displayed in last phase of periodical revision w.e.f 21<sup>st</sup> May which will culminate on 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2022.

5. The Display Centers have been established across the country for inviting claims, objections and applications for corrections which will be adjudicated upon by the Revising Authorities latest by 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. The details of Display Centers and Revising Authorities are given below:

6. After incorporation of decisions of the Revising Authorities, the final electoral rolls will be published on 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. The timelines of remaining activities of the periodical revision 2021-2022 is given below:
